Strike 10 Bowling among new tenants at Mizner Park

Three tenants have inked leases at Boca Raton's [Mizner Park](#): the preview center for Alina Residences, Oakgem jewelry and Strike 10 Bowling & Sports Lounge.

The Alina preview center, managed by Douglas Development Marketing, offers a preview of the Alina Residences in downtown Boca Raton. Prices for the private luxury residences, adjacent to the Boca Raton Resort & Club's gold course, range from under \$1 million to more than \$6 million. Residents are slated to move in starting in 2020.

Oakgem, which specializes in fine estate and designer jewelry, opens in November. It will relocate from Worth Avenue in Palm Beach. Oakgem will host designer and specialty trunk shows.

Strike 10 is slated to open in 2019. It will offer 10 regular and two mini lanes, and a large bar and lounge area. The [Mizner Park](#) location will be the franchise's second. It's current location is in Hallandale Beach in the Village at Gulfstream Park.

[Mizner Park](#), at 327 Plaza Real, is owned by Brookfield Properties Retail Group. It includes dining options, retailers and an iPic movie theater.
