**1 Don Chepo's** The popular Wellington taco shop launched its newest location in the fall at the Boardwalk at Boca Raton. The menu features street-style tacos, quesadillas, burritos and chef's platters.

**2 Park Tavern** The Delray Beach restaurant, known for its large bourbon inventory, is now offering a single-barrel flight (three to five bourbons). The bourbon menu includes hand-selected barrels from Buffalo Trace, Eagle Rare Blanton's and 1792.

**3 El-Ad National Properties** The developer of ALINA Residences Boca Raton has partnered with Habitat for Humanity of South Palm Beach County to donate items from its Mizner on the Green rental units to the non-profit for reuse.

**4 Arts District** The Boca Raton Arts District Association has proposed a new arts district for the area. The \$120-million project will be built on 20 acres of land if passed by the city council.

**5 Boca Raton GreenMarket** In its 22nd year, the farmer's market offers locally grown produce, fresh herbs, baked goods and more every Saturday until May 11.
